EXPERIENCE:

This is an entry level health educator position. Preferred experience includes presenting to small and large groups, working with children; community needs assessment and evaluation, as well as public health experience.

DESCRIPTION OF JOB:

Will work in Randolph County doing educational programs to address nutrition, physical activity, tobacco reduction, and comprehensive school health education. Will provide health promotions to daycare children which may include utilizing puppets, reading books, and interacting with daycare children. Will become a trained car seat technician and provide car seat installation and education. Will do general health education classes as needed or requested in the community. Will be involved with the ongoing assessment of community health needs in Randolph County. Will work with Community Health Services team to accomplish health education and health promotion goals in the community. Will become an American Heart Association instructor within 6 months of hire date and provide CPR classes. Demonstrates ability to prioritize work assignments and work well independently and as a team. Demonstrates time management skills and organizes workload effectively. Demonstrates knowledge of RCHD policies and shows evidence of compliance. This position does require evening and weekend hours as needed.
